- E-Filer: A state committee that has received contributions or made expenditures totaling \$25,000 or more since January 1, 2000.
- Form 460: All state committees, including e-filers, must file paper reports with the Secretary of State. A copy must also be e-mailed to CalPERS at Board Election Coordinator@calpers.ca.gov.
- Forms 496 and 497: All reports filed online only with the Secretary of State and e-mailed to CalPERS at Board Election Coordinator@calpers.ca.gov.
- Candidate Controlled Committees: All committees controlled by a CalPERS candidate must file statements on each filing deadline, in addition to the committee formed for this election.
- Filing Deadlines: Deadlines are extended when they fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or an official state holiday. This extension does not apply to any 24-hour independent expenditure reports (Form 496) or to 24-hour contribution reports (Form 497) that are due the weekend before the election. Such reports must be filed within 24 hours regardless of the day of the week. A \$10 per day late fine may be assessed on both the paper and electronic report resulting in a \$20 per day fine.
- Period Covered: The period covered by any statement begins on the day after the closing date of the last statement filed, or January 1, if no previous statement has been filed.
- Contribution Limits: Contributions to CalPERS candidates are subject to contribution limits of \$4,200 per election. Committees that make contributions to CalPERS candidates are subject to contribution limits of \$7,000 per calendar year.
- **Public Documents:** All forms are public documents. Campaign manuals and instructional materials available at www.fppc.ca.gov, click on the Campaign Rules link.
- Voting Periods: Begin August 28, 2015 and November 6, 2015.
- Section 84200.9 sets pre-election deadlines.
