- The 90-day election cycle begins December 4, 2019 for the March 3, 2020 Special Primary.
- The 90-day election cycle begins February 12, 2020 for the May 12, 2020 Special General.
- Contributions and independent expenditures of \$1,000 or more that are made to or in connection with a candidate being voted on in a special election listed above, or made to a political party committee, must be reported within 24 hours.

- State general purpose recipient committees (other than political party committees), are not required to file regular preelection statements (Form 460) in connection with the SD 28 special elections.
